

## Students and parents



- 1. The AOTC, American Opportunity Tax Credit, can help pay for the rst four years of college if y attend at least half-time. The credit provides up to \$2,500 per s. den. per ear, or p to \$10,0 over fo r ears of ed cation.
- 2. The LLC, <u>Lifetime Learning Tax Credit</u>, can help pay for any level of college or for education courses that advance or improve your job skills. The credit provides up to **\$2,000 per re**, **rn poer.**

These tax credits are available to taxpayers who paid education expenses for themself, their spous or for their dependent. To claim a credit, you must le a Form 1040 or Form 1040-A federal tax retu and complete Form 8863. Form 1098-T contains helpful information needed to complete Form 886

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Most likely you can. Some students may be able to increase their credit by including some of the grant money in the student's income. Students with tuition expenses and Pell Grants or other scholarships should use the resources below to maximize their bene ts.
